UNFPA hereby solicits a quotation for the following service:

“Conducting Research on Menstrual Poverty in Georgia”

UNFPA requires the provision of research services to conduct an evidence-based analytical study on menstrual poverty in Georgia to quantify its scale and key structural drivers.

This Request for Quotation is open to all legally-constituted companies that can provide the requested services and have legal capacity to perform in the country, or through an authorized representative as specified in the Terms of Reference, **Annex II**.

III. Eligible Bidders

This Request for Quotation is open to all eligible bidders; to be considered an eligible bidder for this solicitation process you must comply with the following:

- A bidder must be a legally-constituted company that can provide the requested services and have legal capacity to enter into a contract with UNFPA to deliver in the country, or through an authorized representative.

- A bidder must not have a conflict of interest regarding the solicitation process or with the. Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.
- At the time of Bid submission, the bidder, including any JV/Consortium members, is not under procurement prohibitions derived from the [Compendium of United Nations Security Council Sanctions Lists](#) and has not been suspended, debarred, sanctioned or otherwise identified as ineligible by any [UN Organization](#) or the [World Bank Group](#).
- Bidders must adhere to the UN Supplier Code of Conduct, which may be found by clicking on [UN Supplier Code of Conduct](#).
- No "partial bidding" is accepted.

IV. Content of quotations

Quotations should be submitted via a TWO-envelope system. Interested Bidders are requested to submit their Technical Bid & Declaration From **separately** from their Financial Bid containing the price information. Each envelope shall consist of a single email whenever possible, depending on file size.

- a) **Technical proposal**, in response to the requirements outlined in TOR ([Annex II](#)):
 - o Profile of the bidder and relevance to the Project.
 - o Portfolio of the bidder, demonstrating skills in research design and methods, including sampling and data collection via field surveys.
 - o Proposal of the research with overall description of the research (purpose and methodology),
 - o Schedule of the activities/timeline of the deliverables to be implemented under the project,
 - o CVs of the relevant personnel involved in the project, demonstrating the minimum requirements.
- b) Signed **Declaration Form**, to be submitted strictly in accordance with the document.
- c) **Price quotation**, to be submitted strictly in accordance with the price quotation form.
- d) Relevant registration document(s) issued by a state authority.
- e) Relevant documentation/certification on the sound financial condition of the supplier (e.g. audit reports for the last two years)

Both parts of the quotation must be signed by the bidding company's relevant authority and submitted in PDF format.

V. Instructions for submission

VI. Overview of Evaluation Process

The evaluation will be carried out in a two-step process by an ad-hoc evaluation panel. Technical proposals will be evaluated and scored first, prior to the evaluation and scoring of price quotations.

Technical Evaluation

Technical proposals will be evaluated based on their responsiveness to the service TOR listed in Annex II and in accordance with the evaluation criteria below.

Financial Evaluation

Price quotes will be evaluated only for bidders whose technical proposals achieve a minimum score of **70** points in the technical evaluation.

Price quotes will be evaluated based on their responsiveness to the price quote form. The maximum number of points for the price quote is 100, which will be allocated to the lowest total price provided in the price quotation form. All other price quotes will receive points in inverse proportion according to the following formula:

$$\text{Financial score} = \frac{\text{Lowest quote (\$)}}{\text{Quote being scored (\$)}} \times 100 \text{ (Maximum score)}$$

Total score

The total score for each proposal will be the weighted sum of the technical score and the financial score. The maximum total score is 100 points.

$$\text{Total score} = 70\% \text{ Technical score} + 30\% \text{ Financial score}$$

VII. Award Criteria

In case of a satisfactory result from the evaluation process, UNFPA intends to award a Professional Service Contract on a fixed-cost basis to the Bidder(s) that obtain the highest total score.

VIII. Right to Vary Requirements at Time of Award

UNFPA reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease by up to 20% the volume of services specified in this RFQ without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions.

IX. Payment Terms

UNFPA payment terms are net **30 days upon receipt of invoice and delivery/acceptance of the milestone deliverables** linked to payment as specified in the contract, and shall be made **in Georgian Lari** per official UN exchange rate at the date of transfer. <https://treasury.un.org/operationalrates/OperationalRates.php>

X. Fraud and Corruption

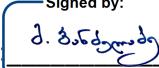
